The White Mountain Waldorf School is seeking a full time, experienced, loving teacher to take the lead in an anticipated Kindergarten Class for the 2017-2018 school year. The anticipated position is dependent on enrollment. The candidate will be a collegial member of the White Mountain Waldorf School faculty.

Our school will celebrate its 32nd year of operation with the 2017–2018 school year. Our school has grown from one Kindergarten to our present size on our 75-acre wooded campus, which serves an average of 85 children with 20 dedicated faculty and staff members. We offer a Parent Child Program, an Early Childhood program for children 2-6 years of age, an Aftercare Program and Elementary Grades 1-8. We have a warm, supportive community of families from the surrounding towns in New Hampshire and Maine.

Our extended Waldorf community consists of an Anthroposophical study group, a bio-dynamic farm, a Community Supported Agriculture group, choral and instrumental groups, and many local opportunities for meditation, yoga, dance, painting and drawing, drama and natural health care.

The ideal candidate will be enthusiastic, warm and energetic, eager to collaborate with teachers and parents, and will have completed Waldorf early childhood training from a WECAN-recognized program and will have Early Childhood classroom management experience. We welcome experienced teachers or teachers who are interested in WECAN Teacher Training. We are interested in candidates who bring the skills of and enthusiasm for working in a developing member school of AWSNA and a full member of WECAN.

Education requirements are a Bachelor's degree and preferred WECAN teacher training or in training. We offer competitive salaries and tuition remission.
